Dwarka Society taps sun's energy to light-up homes

By installing a 100 KW grid-connected rooftop solar plant, the Shiv Bhole Cooperative Group Housing Society in Dwarka has become the first CGHS to go live as part of BRPL' ambitious 'Solar City Initiative - Solarise Dwarka'. Installed as per the RESCO model – at a zero cost to the society - each of the 60 households in the society will save roughly Rs 4500 annually. It will also be able to offset around 32 per cent of a resident's annual carbon emission.

The plant was inaugurated by Dr Wolfram Klein (Head of Division India; South Asia German Federal Ministry of





Economic Cooperation and Development) in the presence of Mr. Amal Sinha (CEO-BRPL), Ms Susanne Dorasil (Head of Economic Cooperation and Development, German Embassy, New Delhi) and senior officials from BMZ, GIZ and residents from the CGHS.
