Delhi CM Inaugurates 500 KW of Rooftop Solar Plants in Dwarka

As part of BRPL' "Solar City Initiative - Solarise Dwarka", grid connected rooftop solar plants of 506 KW were energised on August 4, 2018, in seven CGHS in Dwarka, benefitting over 700 flats. These will cumulatively save around 6.5 lakh units





of energy and Rs 32 lakh annually. Of these, five societies opting for the RESCO business model will get solar electricity at 2.66Rs/kWh, identified through SECI and IPGCL competitive bidding and net of generation based incentive. They didn't have to incur any capex.

These were inaugurated by Delhi's Hon'ble Chief Minister Mr Arvind Kejriwal in the august presence of Hon'ble MLA's Mr Gulab Singh, Mr Naresh Balyan, Mr Rajesh Rishi and Ms Bhawna Gaur. BRPL CEO Mr Amal Sinha led the discom team.

BRPL to plant 15,000 trees

BSES cares for the environment. BRPL and Central Reserve Police Force (CRPF) have partnered to plant 15,000 saplings this year, of which 5118 were planted at the CRPF Camp, Jharoda Kalan in West Delhi in July 2018. Last year too, the discom had planted 15,000 trees.

After signing agreements to procure 250 MW of wind power, BRPL has now inked an agreement with Solar Energy Corporation of India (SECI) to procure 400 MW of solar power. Signed for power a period of 25 years, the solar power is expected to be available from October 2020 at a very competitive tariff of Rs 2.57 per unit, determined through an e auction.


