BSES payment counters to remain open on Sunday, March 26

BSES consumers can get upto Rs 200 cash-back by paying their bill before the due date

Consumers with bill due date in April can also avail cash-back by paying by March 31

For convenience of consumers, cash counters at division offices of BSES Rajdhani Power Limited (BRPL) and BSES Yamuna Power Limited (BYPL) will remain open on Sunday, March 26, 2017, between 9 am and 3 pm. In addition, BSES consumers can also pay their electricity bills on all seven days of the week between 8 am and 8 pm at the 75 Bill Payment Kiosks installed at division offices and select complaint centers.

Cash-back scheme

Around 40 lakh consumers of BRPL and BYPL can get upto Rs 200 cash back on their electricity bills till March 31, 2017. All they have to do is pay the bills before the due-date through the websites / Apps of Paytm, MobiKwik, PhonePe and VISA debit cards.

Consumers with the due date of their electricity bill in April 2017 are also eligible to avail cashback, provided they pay their bill by March 31, 2017. This has been done to enable maximum number of consumers to avail the benefit.

Multiple Payment Options

Apart from E Wallets, consumers can pay their electricity bills conveniently at over 4000 locations, through a wide spectrum of options, including BSES drop boxes, Credit & Debit Cards, Net banking, Auto Debit, neighbourhood Easy Bill, Money N Mobile and Oxigen outlets, ITZ Cash Cards, Bill Payment Kiosks, cheque in mail facility & RTGS / NEFT through banks for Key consumers
