



Reliance Infrastructure led BRPL's CSR programs have been playing their part in making a positive impact in the lives of the needy under its Sparsh initiative. In the month of July, BRPL's CSR programs focused on vocational training, women's health and tree plantation.

## BRPL Self Help Groups stitch and distribute 12000 sanitary napkins and 3000 masks

Reliance Infrastructure led BRPL promoted Women Self Help Groups are stitching and distributing affordable reusable masks & sanitary napkins. During July 2021, over 12000 sanitary napkins and over 3000 masks were stitched and distributed among the needy. These homemade masks are an alternative to the commercial face masks and are made of three layers of tightly woven 100 percent cotton fabric, such as quilter's material with high thread count. Last year, 67,000 masks and over 27,000 sanitary napkins were stitched and distributed.



## Caring for the environment: ~ 13000 trees planted in 40 schools in July

During July, Reliance Infrastructure led BSES Rajdhani Power Limited planted around 13000 tress in July, taking the total counting to ~ 20,000 in the first four months of FY 21-22. Doing its bit, BRPL routinely plants trees in its licensed area. Apart from planting, BRPL's CSR program also tries to ensure high survivability of the saplings at carefully selected locations to ensure that their regular watering is done.





## Over 500 enroll in BRPL's Vocational Training Centers

The past track record of Reliance Infrastructure led BRPL's vocational training program saw ~ 550 students enrolling for the new batch that started in July 2021. Adapting to the 'new normal, BRPL's Vocational Training Centres are conducting online trainings apart from the traditional classes on the job oriented courses on Computers, Beauty and Tailoring. The classes are being undertaken by observing full Covid safety protocols. Last year, after interviews, 140 students had received placement offers, of salaries in excess of Rs 10,000. Of those selected, a large majority were women.

Apart from the fresh enrolment, a certificate distribution program was also organised at the CRPF vocational training centre for the students who had passed out last year.
