Delhi Power Minister Inaugurates BRPL's 66/11 KV Grid Sub Station in Najafgarh

- · It will augment power and water supply in large parts of West Delhi
- · It will serve around 3 lakh people
- Constructed in partnership with Delhi Jal Board (DJB)

The Grid Sub Station was inaugurated by the Hon'ble Minister for Power, Govt of NCT of Delhi, Shri Satyendar Jain today. Constructed at a cost of Rs 24 crore, this 66/11 KV Grid Sub Station will greatly help in catering to large parts of Najafgarh and adjoining areas of West Delhi and serve the growing power needs of around 3 lakh people.

Hon'ble MLAs Shri Kailash Gahlot (Najafgarh Constituency), Shri Gulab Singh Yadav (Matiala), & Shri Naresh Baliyan (Uttam Nagar), and senior officials from the Delhi Government and Delhi Jal Board were also present on the occasion. BSES officials were led by Shri Arvind Gujral (CEO, BRPL).

Speaking at the inauguration, Shri Arvind Gujral said, "This 66/11 KV – 50 MVA Najafgarh Grid Sub Station is a symbol of partnership between BRPL and the Delhi Jal Board (DJB). Part funded by the DJB, this 66/11 KV Grid Sub Station will power the growing needs of the fast developing areas of West Delhi and will also benefit DJB's pumping station and DMRC colony. It will augment the network in areas like Ranaji Enclave, Kiran Garden, Rama Park, Mohan Garden, Sainik Enclave, Anaj Mandi, Deenpur, Goela colony and parts of Vikas Puri. Kakrola, Dwarka Sector 14 and 16 will also benefit form this Grid Sub Station"

"After its commissioning, the Grid Sub Station capacity in the area will increase by 50 MVA. This Grid Sub Station is equipped with the next generation distribution technologies and conforms to stringent international standards. Najafgarh Grid Sub Station will be controlled from the Supervisory Control and Data Access (SCADA).
