BSES's Urban Microgrid System (Solar + Battery) in Shivalik, Malviya Nagar, South Delhi, is garnering significant international interest. Following a recent visit by Ms. Svenja Schulze, the German Federal Minister for Economic Cooperation & Development, another prominent German delegation visited the site. This group was led by Mr. Stefan Wenzel, the German Parliamentary State Secretary of the Federal Ministry for Economic Affairs and Climate Action (BMWK). He was joined by high-ranking officials from the German Embassy, GIZ India, International Solar Alliance, National Solar Energy Federation of India (NSEFI), and Bundesverband Solarwirtschaft (BSW).



Double the Benefits with Rooftop Solar: Lower Electricity Bills and Save the Environment

Consumers, including residential and CGHS groups, are increasingly adopting rooftop solar net metering. BRPL has activated over 4600 rooftop solar connections totaling over 117 MW in South and West Delhi. This method helps reduce electricity bills and benefits the environment.

Residential consumers can receive a government subsidy: 40% for solar systems up to 3kW and 20% for the next 7kW. For more information, visit <https://solar.bsesdelhi.com> or call 19123 (option 8).

The subsidy offered to consumer under national portal is as below:

Solar Plant Capacity	Applicable Subsidy
Upto 3 kW	Rs 14,588 per kW
>3 kW and upto 10 kW	Rs 14,588 per kW upto 3 kW and thereafter Rs 7,294 per kW
Above 10 kW	Fixed Rs 94,822
For RWA's and Group Housing Societies (GHS)	Rs 7294 per kW For common facilities upto 500kWp @ 10kWp per house in that GHS/RWA
