In event of an earth leakage, you can get an electric shock, which can cause a serious bodily injury. These shocks and mishaps can be avoided by installing an Earth Leakage Circuit Breaker (ELCB). This simple yet a very useful device detects



earth leakage, automatically tripping and disconnecting the electricity supply to the premises / equipment, thus preventing serious mishaps.

Under Section 61 A of the Indian Electricity Rules, 1956, it is mandatory for all consumers, to have an ELCB installed at their premises. For your safety and that of your loved ones, we request you to get an ELCB installed.


MCD permissions and Fire Safety Clearance a must for all schools and coaching centres

According to the directions of the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi, educational establishments like coaching centres and schools have to provide MCD permission and Fire Safety Clearance at the time of applying for a new connection.

Further, all the existing educational institutions like coaching centres and schools are advised to ensure that they are in compliance of the fire safety norms and have a valid MCD permission. Without these, electricity is liable to be disconnected.
