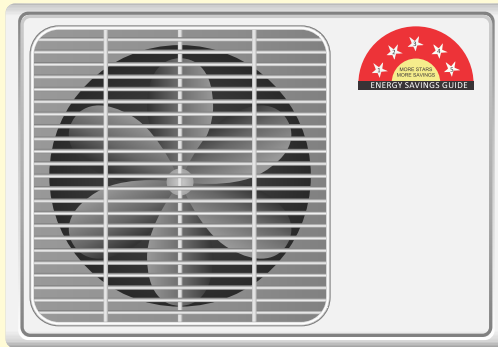
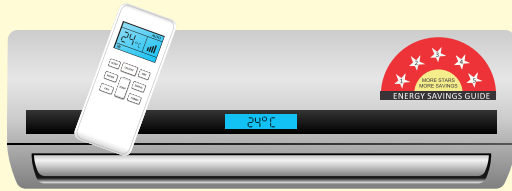

BSES completes electrification of the World's largest Covid facility in a record time

BSES Rajdhani Power Limited (BRPL) completed the electrification work at the World's largest temporary Covid facility with 10,000 beds in a record time around 15-days. Powering this massive facility – equal to around 20 football fields- is an equally massive electricity infrastructure with a load of 23,000 kW & comprising 22 Kms of underground cables & 24 transformers. For catering to this massive load requirement, over 100 discom officials and workers, worked round-the-clock under the direct supervision of the company' senior leadership team and in close coordination with the government and other departments.

The wide-spread use of metal coated manjha – being a good conductor of electricity – poses a great danger not only to the person flying the kite, but also poses a risk to the electricity supply of an area.



- Metal coated manjha can lead to trippings and even electrocution
- Tripping of just one 33/66 KV overhead line can disrupt power supply to over 10,000 residents of an area and tripping of a single 11 KV line to over 2500 residents

Dear Consumer,

For your safety and that of your family members, please spare just 5 minutes a week for a routine safety check around your premises. This is critical for the safety of our home and office.

A weekly check-up is a must to ensure, there are no damaged switches, sockets, wires, cables and other electrical equipments.



- Always use the extension cord properly. If not used safely, it can be dangerous
- If an extension cord is to be used, always use the one with BIS marked cable and wire
- With continuous and regular use, an extension cord can get damaged and may result in electric shocks or even fire
- An extension cord can overheat by overloading or by connecting heavy appliances, which have a higher wattage than the extension cord can handle.
- Never connect two extension cords together as these will put stress on the socket (and the fuse) and will result in overheating and might even cause a fire



- Pull the plug and not the cord when disconnecting from the outlet
- Always cover the extension cord with child proof covers when not in use
- Never run an extension cord through the wall or the ceiling since an overheated cord can cause a serious fire hazard
- Never run an extension cord in between the doors, windows or under any kind of carpet or furniture, as this will break up the insulation of the cord
