BYPL EN-Powered Schools Project launched

The EN-Powered Schools project was launched on 18th September 2024 at MCD Pratibha Vidyalyaya No.4 (Girls), Mayur Vihar, New Delhi, with the aim of promoting energy conservation and renewable energy practices. The initiative's goal is to engage 20,000 students and 200 teachers across 100 MCD schools by 2025. The event was attended by BSES Yamuna Power Limited (BYPL) senior management, Mr. Sunil Kumar, School Incharge and the TERI team.

The launch featured the unveiling of the project mascot, 'Tej', and a session on energy challenges and solutions led by the TERI team. The event also included a Street Play by the Jjiveesha Group to raise awareness. A total of 90 teachers from 66 schools attended the project launch.



BYPL Unveils Mini Science Centres to Enhance STEM Learning

On 6th September 2024, BYPL unveiled Mini Science Centres (MSC) at GBSS, Welcome Colony and GGSS, Welcome Colony, in the presence of the BYPL team and school authorities. A third MSC was inaugurated on 11th September 2024 at GGSS, B Block, Meet Nagar. These schools are part of BYPL's initiative to establish STEM labs at 15 government schools in Delhi, benefitting nearly 30,000 students.

The MSCs aim to shift from traditional rote learning to fostering a deeper, lasting understanding of scientific concepts. This holistic approach ensures that students not only memorize but also apply their knowledge, opening up future possibilities. With 55 MSCs across Delhi in the last two years, BYPL has impacted over 1 lakh students, empowering future engineers and scientists from diverse backgrounds.



BYPL Eye Screening Camps

Under BYPL's CSR Suraksha initiative, completed three free eye screening camps in September this year. The camps are being conducted in collaboration with Ishwar Charitable Trust, unit of ICARE Eye Hospital.

The three camps benefitted 1188 individuals by providing free eye consultations, reading glasses and eye medicines.
