Over 3000 people benefit from BYPL free medical and free eye check-up camps

In October BYPL, conducted 14 free health camps with NGO partner PHD RDF. At these camps 1742 people benefited from the free medical consultations and free medicines.

Additionally, BYPL also organised five eye camps with medical team from I-Care Hospital Noida.and reached out to 1297 people. In all 901 reading glasses and 907 eye drops were provided free to the beneficiaries. Details of the five eye camps are as follows:
