At Seven BYPL Medical Camps 880 people avail free medical help

BYPL CSR Sparsh organised seven free medical camps in February. Over 880 people availed of the free medical consultation and free medicines at these seven camps.

BYPL helped 175 young women get trained in "Cutting and Tailoring" to enable them to supplement their family income by taking up tailoring assignments in their own neighbourhoods. NGO Partner Datamation Foundation Charitable Trust trained 100 women at the centre in Janta Colony and NGO partner HAQ Educational & Social Welfare Society trained 75 women at the Qasabpura, Quresh Nagar centre. Certificates were given out to the successful candidates in the presence of the Yamuna Vihar Business and O&M team at Dwarkapuri Grid on 7 February.

Subsequently, on 28 February, certificates were presented to 75 successful candidates in the presence of the Paharganj Business and O&M Team and RWA representatives at Rahimia Public School, Quresh Nagar.
